

Animal Phylum Matching

These marine animals have plates with spines
Three body parts, jointed legs, tough exoskeleton
Soft, thin, flat bodies
Soft bodied animals usually have a shell
Long animals divided into segments
Jelly-like animals that have a bell or umbrella shape
Animals that have a notochord that supports the body (or backbone)
